

Jan-Mar 2016 Job Openings:

Job vacancies for the economic region

*Labour Market Review
Sept, 2016*

Statistics Canada publishes job vacancy data at national, provincial and economic region levels. **The local economic region includes Sarnia Lambton, Windsor Essex and Chatham-Kent.** This data is collected on a quarterly basis (every three months). Quarter 1 (January to March) results are in for 2016.

Between January and March of 2016, there were 5,830 job openings for the local economic region. The average offered hourly wage was \$16.15. The table below lists the average offered hourly wage by type of occupation.

Trades, transport & equipment operators	\$18.8
Natural resources, agriculture	\$12.2
Manufacturing & utilities	\$14.55
Business, finance & admin	\$19.35
Management	\$26.35
Natural & applied sciences	\$27.15
Edu, law, social, community & governmt	\$17.55
Health	\$22.35
Art, culture, rec & sport	\$13.85
