Job vacancies for the economic region

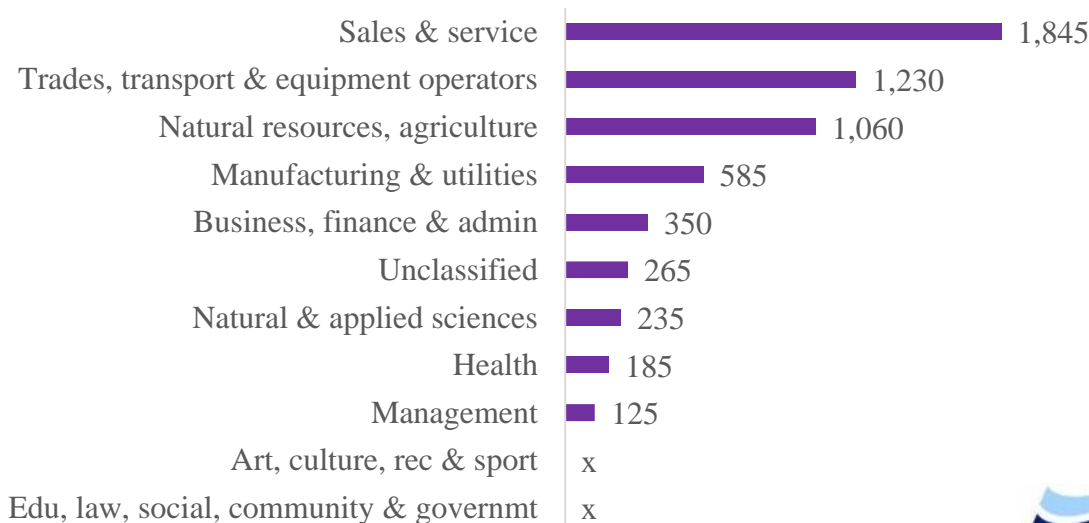
Statistics Canada publishes job vacancy data at national, provincial and economic region levels. **The local economic region includes Sarnia Lambton, Windsor Essex and Chatham-Kent.** This data is collected on a quarterly basis (every three months). Quarter 2 (April to June) results are in for 2016.

Between April and June of 2016, there were 7,255 job openings in the local economic region. There were three unemployed persons for each vacant position. The first quarter of 2016, this ratio was 4:1. The improvement could be linked to seasonal employment related to agriculture and construction for all areas, as well as improved job conditions in Windsor.



The number of job openings by the type of occupation is in the bar chart below. Specific job titles are not available for the economic region but are for the province. For Ontario, the top openings for sales & service related jobs were food counter attendant/kitchen helper, cooks, and servers; for trades the top openings were for transport truck drivers, automotive service technicians, and helpers/labourers.
