






JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR SARNIA & LAMBTON AREA


NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS










DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (SARNIA & LAMBTON AREA)

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?















DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (SARNIA & LAMBTON COUNTY)










JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
