


#### **JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR SARNIA & LAMBTON AREA**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




#### NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS



# **DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (SARNIA & LAMBTON AREA)**


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?








#### **JOB TYPE** Full-time vs Part-time














